

Anett Barsch

Anett Barsch is a member of the Executive Board of Swiss Life Asset Managers Germany with responsibility for the entire project development business.

Having graduated as an architect, she began her career as a partner in the Stadtarchitekten office in the planning and site management area. Prior to that, she had completed a commercial apprenticeship and had worked at a number of companies including Anshen & Allen Architects in the USA, to expand her knowledge of architecture. She then switched to the investment side of the business by working for Heim und Wert Grundbesitz and in 2002 she moved on to Corpus Projektentwicklung Wohnen GmbH, where she held various positions ranging from project management to project development. She was significantly involved in the latter company's growth in the development of new locations and business areas, and was at times responsible for managing its Cologne and Munich offices. In 2011, she was appointed to the position of managing director and was subsequently responsible for a project volume of EUR 2 billion throughout Germany, from purchase to sale. In 2019, Anett Barsch joined the management team of CORPUS SIREO Real Estate GmbH. Following the integration of CORPUS SIREO with Swiss Life Asset Managers in 2021, Anett Barsch continued as a management member of Swiss Life Asset Managers Germany in her role as Head of Development.

In 2016, Anett Barsch was elected to the federal committee of the BFW (Deutschen Berufsförderungswerke) at the Deutscher Immobilien Kongress; she has been a member of the board of this professional federation's regional association for North Rhine-Westphalia since 2014.
